RFUMS Clinical Counseling Pre-Requisite Courses

The Master of Science in Clinical Counseling program does not require prerequisite courses unless the accelerated matriculation option is chosen.

For accelerated matriculation, the following prerequisites must be completed in accordance with the terms of point 7.a.iii above before matriculating at RFU:

PSYC 110 Introduction to Psychological Sciences PSYC 221 Research Statistics and Methods I PSYC 222 Research Statistics and Methods II PSYC 350 Abnormal Psychology

For regular matriculation, the courses above are highly recommended for all applicants. These courses will be adjusted as needed in keeping with this agreement.

Choice of Major:

For accelerated matriculation, majoring in either Psychology, Sociology and Anthropology, or Neuroscience is required + completion of the Health Professions Program (HPP) curriculum.

For regular matriculation, students can major in any major, although Psychology, Sociology and Anthropology, and Neuroscience are recommended majors + completion of the Health Professions Program (HPP) curriculum.
