SPORTS & RECREATION CENTER/ICE RINK Spring 2025 Faculty and Staff Quick Reference

- MEMBERSHIP, ACCESS, AND GUESTS
 - Building hours can be viewed by visiting goforesters.com and navigating to "Inside Athletics" followed by "Facility Hours" - adjusted hours/closures are communicated via e-mail
 - A Lake Forest College ID issued by Public Safety is required for entry into the Sports & Recreation Center
 - Family members (including spouses/domestic partners and children 23 & under) are allowed to use the facility at no charge upon registering
 - Children 15 and under must be accompanied and supervised by an adult on the family account
 - To register your family members, please set up an appointment with Matt Horgan, Athletic Operations and Facilities Assistant (847-735-6153)
 - Faculty and staff are allowed 20 guest passes per year, beginning June 1 of each year
 - Children on a faculty/staff membership are not provided guest passes
 - To register a guest, they must provide a photo ID and will be required to sign a waiver; the SRC does not permit guests under the age of 18 the member must stay with the guest for the duration of their visit
 - o Individual guests may only visit the facility three (3) times before membership is required
- RECREATIONAL USE
 - Recreation equipment is available to members 16 years of age and older at the front desk; an ID card (i.e. driver's license) and/or other collateral (i.e. car keys) is required for check-out
 - Locker rooms #010 and #011 are available to all members for day use only; there are a limited number of overnight lockers available in the faculty/staff locker rooms; if interested please contact Matt Horgan (847-735-6153)
 - Excluding reserved time slots, recreation use of the facility is available on a first-come, firstserved basis – daily schedule is available by viewing Astra
 - Faculty and staff interested in reserving facility space for organized events should contact Assistant Athletic Director Mike Raymond (847-735-6136)
- ICE RINK
 - o A Lake Forest College ID issued by Public Safety is required for entry into the Ice Rink
 - Open Skate times are available only to Lake Forest College students, faculty and staff no guests are permitted
 - Open Skate runs Mon-Fri, 12-3pm throughout the semester any closures during this time will be communicated via e-mail
 - o Students, faculty and staff must provide their own skates
