The following costs are estimated, pending approval by the College's Board of Trustees later in 2023.

Direct Costs will appear on your billing statement while **Indirect Costs** will not. Your *direct costs* may vary, based on your housing assignment and use of the College's health insurance plan. Your actual *indirect costs* may vary, given individual spending habits; the amounts shown are suggested starting points.

Official charges are billed by our Student Accounts team (Business Office) and may differ from those shown.

¹ **The standard rate** applies to the following rooms in residence halls where most first-year students are placed: Doubles, Triples and Quads in Blackstone, Gregory, Harlan, Lois, McClure, Nollen and Roberts, and Stairwell Singles in Gregory, McClure and Roberts. Other rooms and halls have different costs, which will be available at a later date.

² **Choose from three plans**, each with the same cost. Plans are based on the number of "all you can eat meals" in the cafeteria and "flex dollars" to use around campus. **Options include** 10-meals/wk + \$980 flex dollars per semester, 15-meals/wk + \$530 flex dollars, 21-meals/wk + \$215 flex dollars. (Flex dollar amounts are estimated at this time.)

³ Examples include laundry, toiletries, entertainment, etc.

⁴ **All students** must be covered by a U.S. health insurance plan. Students without insurance are billed for the College's plan. Full-year coverage runs from August to August. Single-semester coverage (January to August) of is available for those transferring to the College mid-year. This charge will appear on the initial bill, until and unless proof of acceptable U.S. insurance is provided via the online insurance waiver, available in the summer.

⁵ Charged to all new students, in their first semester of enrollment. It is not applied toward tuition.
