How does it work?

When you go abroad on an ISEP Exchange program, you pay your home institution's tuition, housing and meals and take the spot of a student at another ISEP university.

- Rank your preferred universities; placements depend on space available.
- Programs include packaged housing and meals.

1 EXPLORE YOUR OPTIONS

Visit our website and create an account for your search. Browse by region or use our program filters: location, dates, field of study, language of instruction and more.

2 GET IN TOUCH

Contact your university's study abroad office and meet your on-campus ISEP Coordinator. Your ISEP Student Advisor will also guide you through the application.

3 APPLY!

Rank up to 10 universities and we will place you on a program depending on space and your academic needs. Submit your application by the priority deadlines to be eligible for sites with more limited spots.
