WHEREAS, domestic violence knows no boundaries and exists in all neighborhoods and cities, and affects people of all ages, genders, racial, ethnic, economic and religious backgrounds; and,

WHEREAS, the lifetime economic cost associated with medical services for intimate partner-related injuries, lost productivity from paid work, criminal justice and other costs, was \$3.6 trillion; and,

WHEREAS, there are approximately 125,000 domestic violence crimes each year;

THEREFORE, I, JB Pritzker, Governor of the State of Illinois, do hereby proclaim October 2021 as Domestic Violence Awareness Month in Illinois.
